

Lesson 3 God Invites Me To Be His Ambassador



"You must not use the name of the Lord your God thoughtlessly.

The Lord will punish anyone who is guilty and misuses his name."

Exodus 20:7, ICB



God has called us to do a special job for Him. He needs us to be His ambassadors. What is an ambassador? Ambassadors are good friends with the ruler of the country they represent. When ambassadors speak for their ruler they only give the ruler's opinions and messages.

When Sally lived in Nigeria, an American ambassador lived there who represented the President of the United States. And in the United States there was a Nigerian ambassador who represented the Nigerian President. God's ambassadors are called Christians.



Since he is not talking to God or about Him, "Oh no!" would be a better thing to say.






