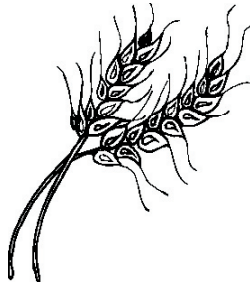
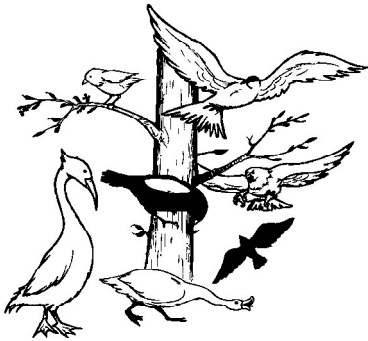




Look up Matthew 6:25-28. Then match the pictures to the blanks in the sentences below. Write the correct number next to each picture.

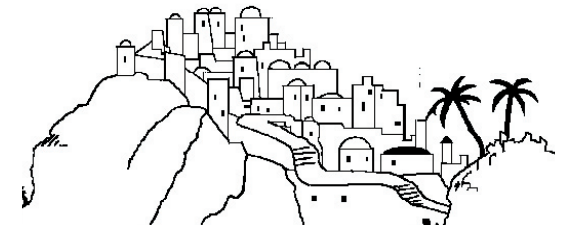

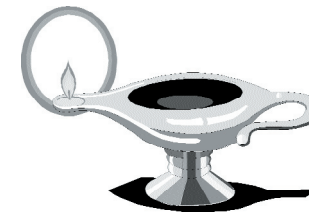

*I am so discouraged. I want to be like Jesus, but I keep forgetting and doing naughty things. Maybe Jesus will not like me.*

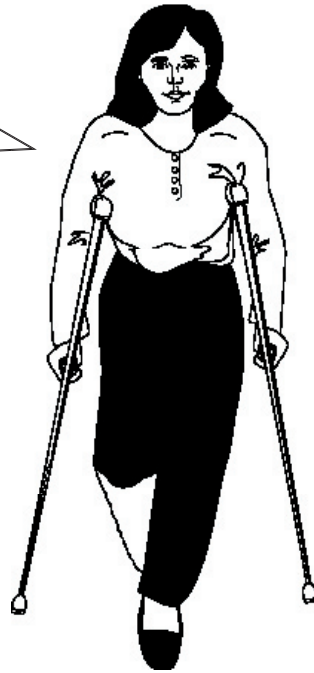
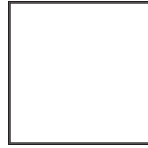

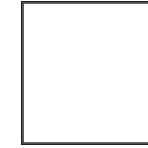


*My dog Sarah died. I miss her so much. I have had her since I was a baby, and I loved her a lot!*
