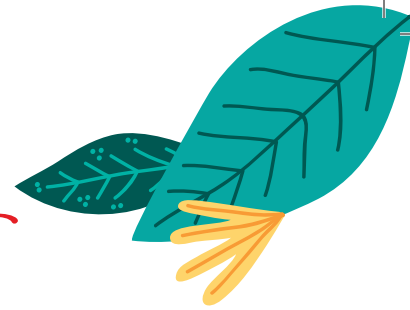

“Ssh, Ssh! did you see what’s moving behind that piece of log?” Marlin whispered excitedly as he moved closer toward the log.

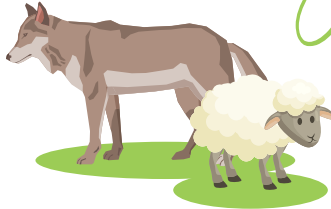
“Okay, Marlin, wait for us,” Jerry said energetically, “Let’s go find out!”
